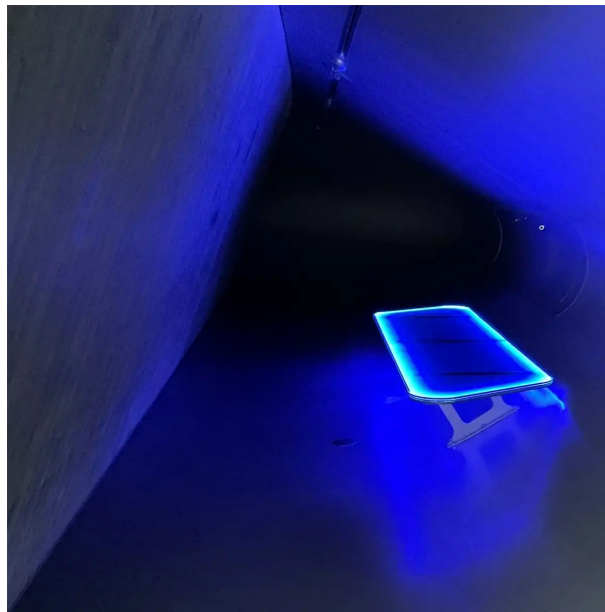


TopoSonic Tunnel

What do you hear in the tunnel?



Step in and listen.

Take a few minutes to sit down in the TopoSonic Tunnel and close your eyes.

Stay for a while in a world made only of sound.

Can you relate some tunes to daily life objects?

Everything in our world makes sounds which often lay beyond the human acoustic window. A buzzing bumblebee, splashing water or a rattling machine – every noise contains frequency bands imperceptible for man. We hear only a small cutout of the world around us.

In the TopoSonic Tunnel (an accessible surround-sound installation) this usually inaudible acoustic inner life of things becomes accessible by virtue of a sophisticated technique. Look at (or better, listen to) natural sounds, such as the chirps of crickets, bird twittering, blowing air, or the sound of a rolling sphere through an "audio microscope".
