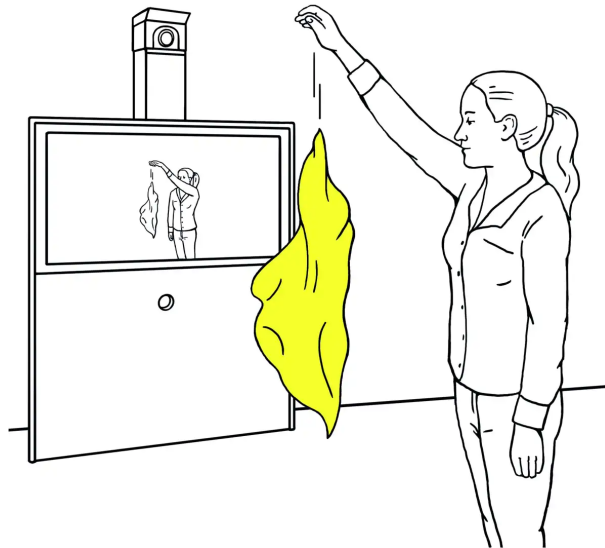


Do undo

Can you pick up a cloth from the floor without touching it?



Wait until the recording starts and then move in front of the screen.

Take a look at your recording.

Can you capture actions that seem completely impossible in reverse?

Perform an action backwards so that it appears normal when the film is reversed.

There are processes that can be reversed at any time. These processes are called reversible. A knotted rope can be untied again, hikers climb up and down a mountain. So-called irreversible processes cannot run in the opposite direction: a burst balloon cannot be repaired, a cherry-banana juice cannot be separated again.

Do-Undo (original name) is an installation by media artist Ed Tannenbaum. In his 30 years of activity, the American has worked and implemented works of art on almost every continent. The audience is a crucial part of his installations, which only come to life through the interaction of the visitors.
