STAGES OF PREGNANCY.

These are life-size models of foetuses taken at different stages of pregnancy.

PRESS the square buttons to see images from each stage of pregnancy.

Use the trackball and button to navigate through the information on the screen.

On the ultrasound images you can recognize the movements of the foetus, its heartbeat, the structure of its skull and its limbs, its sexual characteristics, the umbilical cord and the placenta.

Weeks 1 to 9: The embryo develops into the foetus. The most important organs are formed and work.

Weeks 10 to 12: The head is about as large as the remainder of the body.

From week 16: Pregnant mothers can already feel kicks in their tummy.

From week 30: The kicks and movements decrease. The foetus moves into position, ready to be born.
