YOUR FATHER'S NOSE.



SIT on one side of the mirror.

ASK another person to sit opposite to you on the other side of the mirror.

PLACE the images of your heads on top of each other. Take care of the right position of your heads. By moving back and forth you can adjust the size of your reflections.



The result is a mixed face from your two heads.

You see yourself only partly in the mirror stripes. In the interstices, you see the person on the other side of the mirror. The more similar you are, the less noticeable it is that you look at a mixed face.

With the stripy mirror striking parts of the face, like nose or chin can be 'exchanged' completely.
